HACCP Australia is a registered business with the Australian Business Number (ABN) 71 079 739 816. The registered office of HACCP Australia is Level 2, 222 Pitt Street, Sydney, NSW 2000. This data privacy policy statement governs the privacy of HACCP Australia's website and the users who choose to visit it. ## Use of 'cookies'

This website may use cookies to better the users' experience while visiting the website. As required by legislation, and where applicable, this website uses a cookie control system, allowing the user to give explicit permission or to deny the use of /saving of cookies on their computer / device.

What are cookies? Cookies are small files saved to a user's computer hard drives that track, save and store information about a user's interactions and usage of the website. This allows the website, through its server, to provide
